Aim

At St Joseph's Pre-School Unit we aim to ensure that our premises are suitable, clean, and a safe place for children to be cared for, where they can grow and learn. We aim to meet all statutory requirements about fire safety and fulfil the criteria for meeting the relevant Early Years Foundation Stage Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements.

Objectives

- At St Joseph's Pre-School Unit, we recognise that we have a responsibility and a duty of care for those who work in and receive a service from our Pre-School Unit, but individual employees and service users also have a responsibility to ensure their own safety as well as that of others. Risk assessments are the key means through which this is achieved.
- A fire safety risk assessment is carried out by a competent person in accordance with the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (This is carried out by St Joseph's Pre-School Unit).
- A Fire Log is kept, and details of fire drills are recorded.
- Necessary equipment is in place to promote fire safety (This is provided and maintained by St Joseph's Catholic Primary School).
